- 4. New applications to vote by post at this referendum or written instructions to change or cancel an existing postal or proxy voting arrangement must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Follaton House, Plymouth Road, Totnes, Devon TQ9 5NE by 5pm on Tuesday 12 February 2019.
- 5. Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Follaton House, Plymouth Road, Totnes, Devon, TQ9 5NE by 5 p.m. on Tuesday 19 February 2019.
- 6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Follaton House, Plymouth Road, Totnes, Devon, TQ9 5NE by 5 p.m. on Wednesday 27 February 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 p.m. on 19 February. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 p.m. on 19 February 2019.
