Application has been made for a grant of £10,000 to the Prince's Countryside Fund and GA hopes for a response by 11th December.

2.Sports Officer: JJ

Tennis courts; tarmac has been laid and the perimeter fencing and posts are awaited. Temporary tennis court lining will be laid next, and final tennis court and netball court lining will be completed in the spring of 2021.

Senior pitch. Nets have been erected by the children's play area.

3. Bookings Secretary: VJ

Following the recent reintroduction of the cupbeard 19 lockdown precautions, VJ has notified all hirers that the Hall ad Annexe will be closed until further notice. She will notify them as soon as the Hall has reopened and has confirmed all that a full cleaning is being conducted to ensure that we maintain our usual high standard.

She has received a request from Caroline Mercer, a local artist, who has provisionally booked the Annexe for 5 December when she will hold an exhibition in the Annexe in the morning, with timed entry to ensure that appropriate social distancing is maintained.

It is possible that she may hold art lessons in the afternoon. Both events to be confirmed as the situation dictates.

4. Projects

a. The Old Pavilion

The repairs to the Old Pavilion are now virtually complete, and the builders have been paid the balance due to them. There remain one of two items to be addressed, principally the refixing of the pedestrian door bolt, to replace the screws with coach bolts.

Tim and Bridget have spent several sessions sorting out what remains in the building, and will arrange shortly for the remaining rubbish to be removed.

Following a minor alteration still required to the internal structure of the building, not part of the original contract, it will then be possible for AM to refit all the electrical installations including the main input cable which is currently hanging free. Also the consumer unit and switchboard which needs to be reattached to the new end wall.

The lengths of hosepipe have been carefully looped inside the storage locker on the west side. The various sacks containing sand and other substances for use on the fields have been stored together in the new additional space. Most of the iron road pins are now stored horizontally on brackets, again in the new storage area.

Smaller items including the floodlight previously above the North door, are now stored in the new cupboard at the kitchen end.

It is hoped that the project will be completed and items currently held in the Garage placed back in the old Pavilion by the end of November.
